I look forward to teaching your child Math this year. Here are the main strategies that I implement to help facilitate students' success.

PLEASE CHECK EACH BOX TO CONFIRM THAT YOU HAVE READ THE STATEMENT.

1. Students are NOT permitted to have their cell phones during class. Phones **cannot** be used as calculators. Students with their phone during class time will have it confiscated as per school policy.

2. Homework will be assigned for each concept learned throughout the year. Assigned work is to be completed and checked online before students' next class. IXL will be used for homework and formative assessment.

3. It is students' responsibility to note and complete homework requirements. Homework will be posted:

1. on the Homework board in class,
2. using Microsoft Office TEAMS, and
3. on my website, jacksonsymmesmath.weebly.com

4. Due to Covid, it is essential that all students have their own school supplies. Students need

- a. MTH 7 workbook (provided),
- b. Calculator,
- c. Pencil and eraser,
- d. Coloured pen.

6. Students are expected to correct test errors using a coloured pen. These corrections must then be resubmitted, and will be used a part of their class assignment mark.

7. All assignments are to be handed in at the start of class on the date due. If the student is absent on due date, it must be submitted immediately upon return. Students are responsible to pick up any assignments missed and submit at new deadline.

8. My website, jacksonsymmesmath.weebly.com, includes links to instructional videos, homework answers (after reviewed in class) and other learning resources to allow students to continue their learning away from class. The TEAMS class will also have resources posted.
